



5. Mode of Selection

Selection will be done as per the norms of West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board and Govt. of West Bengal.

6. DOCUMENTS REQUIREDMENT FOR THE ADMISSION:

ii) Mark sheet of H.S/Equivalent Examination (Admission of the candidate will be cancelled, in case of Fake Mark sheet/Age-proof document detected on verification from concerned Council/ Board).

iii) Age proof (The documents include Admit Card/Certificate of Madhyamik Examination/ Mark sheet of the Examination Board/Council like (CBSE/ICSE)

iv) Admit Card, Rank Card and Allotment Letter of West Bengal Joint entrance Examination Board.



v) Competent Authorities for the issuance of Domicile Certificate. (As per the guideline of the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board). District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector, Sub-Division officer, Block-Development Officer.

In corporation area - Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint commissioner, assistance Commissioner. Assistant Secretary or above in the secretariat to the govt. of West Bengal (including GTA) or central Govt. Note: Domicile certificate issued by any elected people's representative such as Municipal commissioner, Councillor of Municipal Corporation/Municipality, Member of the three-tier panchayat system or GTA, MLA or MP are not acceptable.

vi) Valid certificates for SC/ST/OBC (As per the guideline of the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board)

vii) Medical Fitness certificate (As per the guideline of the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board)

7. LEAVE AND HOLIDAYS

- i) Vacation: 4 weeks per year
- ii) Gazetted Holidays: As recommended by West Bengal Nursing Council
- iii) Preparatory Leave: 1 (one) Week before West Bengal Nursing Council Examination (In case of absence in class/experience, make-up of the same has to be done within the sameacademicyear)

8. EXAMINATION SYSTEM

- i) At the end of each Academic Year, Annual Examination will be conducted by West Bengal Nursing Council.
- ii) Student has to obtain 50% as Pass Marks in all Theory/Practical Papers (External & Internal) separately.
- iii) Class Test/ Periodical Test/ Test Examination of both theory and practical papers of all the subjects will be conducted as per the schedule made by the Institution following the council guideline.

9. Eligibility for Examination:

Candidate will be eligible for the Council Examination after being recommended by the Head of the Institute, provided she has completed the required Hours of Classes and Clinical Experiences as per syllabus.

10. Registration under Indian Nursing Council/West Bengal Nursing Council

- i) The Student will be recommended for Final Registration in Indian Nursing Council and State Nursing Council (West Bengal Nursing Council) as "Registered Nurse Midwife" after successful completion of the Course along with Internship.
- ii) The Student has to complete her recommended clinical experiences before leaving the Institution. The Diploma will not be awarded to the student till she completes her requirement.

11. Rules and Regulations of the Institution

- i) 100% attendance is mandatory in both theory and practical papers of all the subjects along with clinical and field experiences as mentioned in the syllabus of Indian Nursing Council.
- ii) Wearing of the recommended uniform of Institute is mandatory during class/ clinical hours
- iii) Students are not allowed to meet the guardians/relatives/outsiders during working hours



- iv) Students are not allowed to carry a mobile phone during class/ clinical hours
- v) Android Phones are allowed to the students for the period of online classes and study hours.
- vi) In case of gross misconduct of the student, she may be detained/ terminated from the ongoing course at any time during the academic year as per decision of the management.
 - In such case, fees already submitted are not refundable.

vii) RAGGING IS A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE

- Ragging to anyone anywhere is strictly prohibited.
- If anyone detected for the act, will not be able to continue the course.

12. DISPUTES

• Any dispute arising out of the admission process/any proceedings thereof shall lie within the jurisdiction of existing rules and principles.

13. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HOSTEL

The students will have to stay at hostel of SNNA, in shared room with their classmates. Change of room will be there within 3 years tenure.

Rules for outing from Hostel:

- > Guardian's permission is obligatory
- > Day Pass: Only on Sunday & Holiday From 7 AM to 7 PM
- > Out Pass: Only on Wednesday/Saturday/ Sunday & Holiday From 5 PM to 7 PM
- One has to compensate her absence from duty due to sickness/absence from classes or absence from clinical experiences.
- Rooms should be kept clean and tidy. Students are fully responsible for any loss/damage of furniture/fixture allotted to them and compensation will be charged for loss, breakage and manhandling
- Proper locks be used for cupboards and boxes. Jewellery and expensive items are not allowed in the room. The authority shall not remain responsible for any theft/loss/damage of personal belongings of the students.
- · Wastage of water, electricity and food is strictly prohibited.
- Students should come to the dining hall/canteen in proper dress.
- Students in case fall sick, should report to the HostelWarden and also to the Class Co-ordinator through class monitors during the class hours.
- It is mandatory to attend the roll call at the hostel. The students have to sign in their specific column during departure from and arrival to the Hostel in the presence of the Hostel Warden.
- The ward will be treated absent if she does not attend the Roll Call/Sign at the time of arrival/ departure.
- Students will have to maintain the study hour as per the decision of the authority
- No cooking appliances are allowed in the student'sroom in the hostel.
- Android Phones are allowed to the students only for stipulatedhours of the day
- Visitors are not allowed inside the student's room in the hostel.
- Lending and borrowing of money & jewellery is strictly prohibited.
- Changes of address and mobile no. to be informed immediately to the institutionand the hostel superintendent.
- · Leave and vacation days areto be granted by the Institution.
- No students is allowed to take Half-Day Leave.
- Lights and Fans must be switched off before leaving the hostel and the doors must be locked before leaving the room.
- If thestudents violating the above mentioned rules-will be asked to discontinue.
